The dentist was also very kind to us in not charging for the unsuccessful root canal and charging quite agreeable prices otherwise!

These opportunities, along with regular soul winning and language lessons, have been a great help to me. I am very grateful for steady progress in the long journey of language and cultural learning.

Also during April, we greatly enjoyed celebrating the Resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ, at Iglesia Bautista Fidelidad! They had a delicious potluck breakfast, to which Brittany brought some scrumptious cinnamon rolls. Pastries that are so sweet do not seem to be a common thing down here, so one of the ladies in the church, Berenice, asked Brittany for the recipe. Brittany was able not only to give the recipe but also to teach Berenice how to make cinnamon rolls — all in Spanish! I can tell you that Brittany is making great progress in learning Spanish, but this is obviously a great sign of her improvement because of her hard work.

At the end of the month, we celebrated Día del Niño (Kids' Day), as that is celebrated here in México. The festivities at church included pizza, games for the kids, a giant piñata, and the kids of the church singing a special song. Charity joined the others, making this her first time singing a special in church. We are proud of Charity for stepping out of her comfort zone in doing this!
